**DEPUTY BAILIFF:** We think it is clear from the transcript that the learned relief Magistrate relied to a great extent, if not entirely on the evidence of the witness for the prosecution, Mr. Queree. I think for the reasons you have set out and submitted to us Mr. Thacker, we think that his evidence was unreliable. Accordingly, we have come to the conclusion it would be unsafe to maintain the conviction. The appeal is allowed. You have your legal aid costs.
