BAILIFF: "Dean, everything you have said with the exception of the fact that you are now reading for an 'A' Level in prison, was all before the Inferior Number and having regard to the general principles of sentencing which this Court follows, it cannot find that although it might possibly have itself imposed a slightly lesser sentence had it been the sentencing Court, it cannot say that the decision of the Inferior Number was manifestly excessive and the appeal is dismissed. Is this a Legal Aid case? No.
