Bailiff:-

One normally does what one can to keep young people out of prison, but these are exceptional circumstances Mr. Renouf, where, for his own good he really ought to stay in, until we can assess him and until there is a possibility of his going to a hostel, again for further assessment as the previous offences, as you have said, have been drink related. Having regard to the facts also, this is a very serious offence; to carry a (indistinct) pistol, even if it was accidental - we do not know exactly what it was - but it could have led to a very difficult confrontation. For his own protection, and in order that a proper assessment can be made, he must stay in prison. Application refused.
