## JUDG MENT

BAILIFF: The Housing form was very clear as to what could and could not be done and although the defendant company may have been under a misapprehension as to the powers of what it could or could not do, again, it was a question of going to the Housing Committee to find out and we really cannot think that a transaction of this nature, because it was very clearly contrary to the condition, merits other than the conclusions asked for by the Crown Advocate and therefore the company is fined £750 on each charge and £350 costs.
