JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: Everything that has been said this morning was said in September when Harris was placed on probation. He has breached that probation order three times and it becomes a mockery of the Orders of the Court. Until the authorities can find other means of dealing with these people, the Court has no alternative, as the Attorney General has rightly said, but to protect society. Therefore the conclusions are granted. Harris, you are sentenced to six months' imprisonment.
