JUDGMENT

DEPUTY BAILIFF: The view of the Court is that failure to open a recorded delivery letter, which must obviously be more than normal documentation is unforgivable and therefore the conclusions are right and proper. So Mr. Holmes is fined in respect of the first infraction, £100 or in default of payment, one month's imprisonment; and on the second infraction, £500 fine or in default, three months' imprisonment,

consecutive, making a total of £600 or four months' imprisonment, and the Court orders the payment of £200 by way of costs.
