**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The M80/A80 Trunk Road (Dennyloanhead to Mollinsburn)  
(Temporary Width Restriction on Vehicles) Order 2011**

*Coming into force*

*24th April 2011*

The Scottish Ministers make the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 2(1) and (2), 4(1) and 14(1)(a) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), and all other powers enabling them to do so.

In accordance with section 14(1)(a) of that Act, they are satisfied that the traffic on the length of road specified in the Schedule should be prohibited because works are being or are proposed to be executed on or near that length of road.

In accordance with section 14(3) of that Act, they have had regard to the existence of alternative routes suitable for traffic which will be affected by this Order.

**Citation, commencement and cessation**

1. This Order may be cited as the M80/A80 Trunk Road (Dennyloanhead to Mollinsburn) (Temporary Width Restriction on Vehicles) Order 2011, comes into force on 24th April 2011 and ceases to have effect at 0001 hours on 1st September 2011.

**Temporary width restriction on vehicles**

2. Subject to article 3, no person shall use, or permit the use of, any vehicle having a width exceeding 2 metres on the length of road specified in the Schedule, when such prohibition is identified as applying to any part or parts of the said length of road by means of one or more of the traffic signs prescribed in Diagram 629 of the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b).

The functions of the Secretary of State were transferred to the Scottish Ministers by section 53 of the Scotland Act 1998 (c.46).

**Exemption for emergency and works vehicles**

3. This Order shall not apply to a vehicle while being used in an emergency for fire brigade, coastguard, ambulance or police purposes or a vehicle being used for carrying out the works.

That length of the M80/A80 Glasgow-Stirling Trunk Road from its junction with the M876 Dennyloanhead – Gartarry Roundabout Trunk Road to the Luggie Water overbridge at Mollinsburn, a distance of 12.8 kilometres or thereby.
