JUDGMENT

 - 3.1.3 £849.50 for unlawful deductions from wages.

Giving a total judgment sum of £5,261.48.

- 4. In respect of each claimant, on the claimant's application, the question of remedy for unfair dismissal is stayed until further application by the claimant. If no such further application is made by 30 June 2018 the claims will stand as dismissed without further order.
- 5. The hearing fixed for 2 January 2018 is vacated.
