JUDGMENT

- 1. By a letter dated **7 August 2018** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim of unfair dismissal should not be struck out because the claimant does not appear to have the requisite service of 2 years in order for the tribunal to have jurisdiction for such a claim.
- 2. The claim is therefore struck out. The claimant is reminded that any correspondence to the tribunal must be copied to the respondent.
