JUDGMENT

The claim of unfair dismissal is struck out.

REASONS

1. By a letter dated **7 August 2018** the Tribunal gave the claimant an opportunity to make representations or to request a hearing, as to why the claim of unfair dismissal should not be struck out because the claimant does not appear to have the requisite service of 2 years in order for the tribunal to have jurisdiction for such a claim.

2. While the claimant’s emails of 10 August 2018 are noted, the claimant has failed to make sufficient representations as to why this should not be done or to request a hearing, as these emails do not adequately address the issue. The claim is therefore struck out. The claimant is reminded that any correspondence to the tribunal must be copied to the respondent.

3. The hearing fixed for 26-27 March 2019 has been reduced to 3 hours and will take place on 26 March 2019 only, commencing at 10:00.
