## **JUDGMENT**

The claimant's claim for a redundancy payment is struck out.

## **REASONS**

- 1. The claimant claims a redundancy payment.
- 2. Section 108 of the Employment Rights Act 1996 requires a claimant to have not less than two years service to make claim for a redundancy payment.
- 3. The claimant was employed by the respondent for less than two years.
- 4. Therefore the claimant is not entitled to bring such a claim.
- 5. The claimant has failed to give an acceptable reason, despite being given the opportunity to do so, why the claim should not be struck out.
- 6. Accordingly, the claim for a redundancy payment is struck out. The claimant's other complaints are not affected by this judgment, and will be heard on 18 March 2020.
