JUDGMENT

The judgment of the Tribunal is that:

- The claims of unlawful deduction from wages, outstanding holiday pay and failure to provide the claimant with written terms of employment are dismissed.
- 2. The claimant's employment with the respondent ended on 16 December 2019, the claimant commenced early conciliation on 4 September 2020. The claim was presented on 20 November 2020.
- 3. All of the claims are thus out of time. The Tribunal had no jurisdiction to hear the claims.
