JUDGMENT

Unauthorised deduction from wages

- 1. It is declared that the respondent made unauthorised deductions from the claimant's wages.
- 2. The respondent shall pay to the claimant the sum of £21634.50 being the amount of the unauthorised deductions calculated as follows:
 - (a) Unpaid wages for January, February and March 2022 in the sum of £6000 gross per month.
 - (b) Unpaid pension contributions between June 2021 and March 2022 inclusive of £363.34 per calendar month being £3634.50 in total.

Unfair dismissal

- 1. It is declared that the claimant was constructively unfairly dismissed on 1 April 2022.
- 2. The respondent shall pay to the claimant a basic award in the sum of £1088.
- 3. Upon the Tribunal finding that the claimant's employment would have come to an end on 30 April 2022 in any case, there shall be a compensatory award of one months' loss of wages with the claimant giving credit for the monies earned

in alternative employment for the month of April 2022. There shall therefore be a compensatory award in the sum of £1561.42.

Total award

The sums awarded totalling £24,283.92 shall be paid by the respondent to the claimant on or before **2 December 2022**
