Their Lordships will humbly advise His Majesty that the Decree appealed from should be reversed with costs. The Respondent Baldeo Bakhsh Singh not having accepted the offer that the 12 annas share should be redeemed, their Lordships will humbly advise His Majesty that an order should be made declaring that the Appellant is entitled by virtue of the mortgage deed dated the 10th of December 1888 to redeem the 4 annas share comprised in the mortgage deed dated the 5th of September 1879, with consequential directions.

The Respondent Baldeo Bakhsh Singh will pay the costs of the Appeal.
