3.—The Respondent Board of Directors of the Canada Life Assurance Company has no interest in the subject matter of these appeals otherwise than as a body in which by the terms of the Wills of the Testator and Testatrix, if the bequests, the subject matter of these appeals, are valid, certain discretionary powers are vested and save in so far as the establishment of the validity of the said bequests might incidentally or indirectly benefit the Canada Life Assurance Company for the well-being of which the Respondent Board of Directors of the Canada Life Assurance Company is responsible.

10 4.—These Respondents do not desire to be heard in argument upon these appeals and will submit to whatever order Her Majesty in Council may think fit to make in the premises, humbly submitting that provision should be made for their costs.
