**The M6 Motorway Junction 32 (Southbound Link Road to the
M55 Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order
2010**

Made - - - - *1 September 2010*

Coming into force - - *19 September 2010*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M6 Motorway and its link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the District of Preston in the County of Lancashire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order.

1. This Order may be cited as the M6 Motorway Junction 32 (Southbound Link Road to the M55 Westbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 19 September 2010.

2. In this Order;

“the link road” means the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M6 Motorway at Junction 32 to the westbound carriageway of the M55 Motorway;

“works” means parapet repair works at Fylde Junction Higher Bridge;

“the works period” means periods overnight between 2300 hours and 0600 hours starting on Monday 20 September 2010 and ending on Monday 4 October 2010. However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
