ROAD TRAFFIC

The M5 Motorway (Junction 19) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010

Made - - - - 6 September 2010

Coming into force - - 8 September 2010

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M5 Motorway ("the M5") and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads at Junction 19 in North Somerset should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M5 Motorway (Junction 19) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 8 September 2010.

2. In this Order –

"the first slip road" means the southbound exit slip road at M5 Junction 19;

"the second slip road" means the northbound exit slip road at M5 Junction 19;

"the works" mean renewal of the junction signal controllers at M5 Junction 19 together with the replacement and upgrade of plant and surfacing;

"a first works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Thursday 9 September 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

"a second works period" means a period of 11 hours starting at 19.00 hours on Thursday 9 September 2010 or any subsequent day and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a first works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the first slip road.
- **4.** Subject as mentioned in article 5, no person shall, during a second works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour in the second slip road.
