**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A21 Trunk Road (Castle Hill – Kipping’s Cross)  
(Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010**

*Made* - - - - - *13th December 2010*  
*Coming into force* - - - - - *8th January 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A21 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A21 Trunk Road (Castle Hill – Kipping’s Cross) (Temporary Speed Restrictions) Order 2010 and shall come into force on 8th January 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A21 Trunk Road near Pembury in the County of Kent;

“the length of trunk road” means both carriageways of the trunk road between a point 800 metres north of its junction with Pembury Walks and Kipping’s Cross roundabout (B2160);

“works” mean resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 10th January 2011 or on any subsequent day until 7th July 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding –

(a) 10 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while traffic signs of a character authorised under section 64 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 indicating “convoy working” on that length of road are displayed; or

(b) 40 miles per hour on the length of trunk road while the traffic signs specified in paragraph (a) of this article in relation to that length of road are not displayed.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes.
