ROAD TRAFFIC

The M62 Motorway Junction 10 (Westbound Link Road to the M6 Northbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

 Made
 16th May 2011

 Coming into force
 2nd June 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M62 Motorway and its link roads, is satisfied that traffic on one of those link roads in the District of Warrington should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the M62 Motorway Junction 10 (Westbound Link Road to the M6 Northbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd June 2011.

2. In this Order:

"motorway" means the M62 Motorway;

"works" means the removal of vegetation and lighting column renewal works on the motorway link road;

"the works period" means a period overnight between 2200 hours and 0500 hours starting on Friday 3 June 2011 and ending on Saturday 4 June 2011.

However, work may start and continue between the same times on subsequent nights or continue overnight until completed, for such period not exceeding 18 months as shall be required to complete the work;

"the link road" means the link road leading from the westbound carriageway of the motorway at Junction 10 to M6 Motorway northbound carriageway.

- 3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the works period, no person shall cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the link road.
- 4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
