ROAD TRAFFIC

The A3 Trunk Road (Thursley Junction - Hindhead) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *6th June 2011*
Coming into force - - *25th June 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on a length of that road and on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Thursley Junction - Hindhead) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 25th June 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A3 Trunk Road in the County of Surrey;

“the length of carriageway” means the southbound carriageway of the trunk road between a point 340 metres north of the centre of Thursley junction (Old Portsmouth Road) and its junction with the A287 at Hindhead;

“the slip road” means the road leading to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Thursley junction (Old Portsmouth Road);

“works” mean essential carriageway repairs and associated work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 27th June 2011 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Friday 1st July 2011 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 2nd July 2011 or on any subsequent Saturday, or
- (iv) 7½ hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 3rd July 2011 or on any subsequent Sunday,

until 24th December 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the length of carriageway or the slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform;
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
- (e) a vehicle proceeding in a length of carriageway to or from premises accessible from, and only from, that carriageway, to such extent as shall be indicated by traffic signs.
