ROAD TRAFFIC

The A27 Trunk Road (Coldean Interchange – Falmer Interchange) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011

Made - - - - *13th June 2011*
Coming into force - - *2nd July 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A27 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be restricted on a length of that road and prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A27 Trunk Road (Coldean Interchange – Falmer Interchange) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd July 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A27 Trunk Road in the County of East Sussex and the City of Brighton & Hove;

“the eastbound carriageway” means the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road between the centre of the eastern Greatwood Footbridge west of Coldean Interchange (A270) and a point 300 metres west of the centre of the B2123 overbridge at Falmer Interchange;

“the slip road” means the road leading from the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road to the B2123 at Falmer Interchange (B2123);

“works” mean resurfacing work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of 10 hours starting at 2000 hours on Monday 4th July 2011 or on any subsequent day until 1st January 2013.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the slip road.

4. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6 below, no person shall, during a works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the eastbound carriageway.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.

6. (1) Nothing in article 3 above shall apply to -
- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
 - (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, traffic officer or fire and rescue authority purposes;
 - (c) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes; or
 - (d) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform.
- (2) Nothing in article 4 above shall apply to a vehicle being used for police, ambulance or fire and rescue authority purposes and to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011(a) when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
