**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A47 Trunk Road (Wisbech Level Crossing,  
Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - 30th August 2011

*Coming into force* - - 6th September 2011

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A47 Trunk Road (“the A47”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road in the County of Cambridgeshire should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

**1.** This Order may be cited as the A47 Trunk Road (Wisbech Level Crossing, Cambridgeshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 6th September 2011.

**2.** Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 11 hours starting at 22:00 hours on Saturday 10th September 2011, or on any subsequent day until works to resurface the approaches to Wisbech level crossing have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A47 from its junction with Cromwell Road Roundabout to a point 30 metres east of the centre line of Wisbech level crossing.

**3.** The provisions of article 2 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used in connection with the works or for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes.
