**The Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment)  
Order 2011**

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the powers conferred by section 8B(5) of the Immigration Act 1971<sup>(a)</sup>:

**1.** This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) (Amendment) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 28th February 2011.

**2.** At the end of Part 1 of the Schedule to the Immigration (Designation of Travel Bans) Order 2000<sup>(b)</sup> add “Resolution 1970(2011) of 26th February 2011 (Libya).”.
