**ROAD TRAFFIC**

**The A3 Trunk Road (Wisley Interchange, Southbound)  
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011**

*Made* - - - - *14th March 2011*  
*Coming into force* - - *2nd April 2011*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A3 Trunk Road and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic should be prohibited on one of those connecting roads because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A3 Trunk Road (Wisley Interchange, Southbound) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2011 and shall come into force on 2nd April 2011.

2. In this Order:

“the trunk road” means the A3 Trunk Road in the County of Surrey;

“lay-by” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002(b);

“the A3 lay-by” means the lay-by in the entry slip road to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Wisley Interchange (M25 Junction 10);

“the side road” means Old Lane at its junction with the entry slip road to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Wisley Interchange (M25 Junction 10);

“the slip road” means the road leading from the roundabout at M25 Junction 10 to the southbound carriageway of the trunk road at Wisley Interchange;

“works” mean improvement work on the trunk road; and

“a works period” means a period of –

- (i) 7½ hours starting at 2200 hours on Monday 4th April 2011 or on any subsequent day other than a Friday, Saturday or Sunday,
- (ii) 7 hours starting at 2300 hours on Friday 8th April 2011 or on any subsequent Friday,
- (iii) 8 hours starting at 2200 hours on Saturday 9th April 2011 or on any subsequent Saturday, or

(iv) 7 hours starting at 2230 hours on Sunday 10th April 2011 or on any subsequent Sunday,  
until 1st October 2012.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 below, no person shall, during a works period, cause or permit any vehicle –

- (a) to enter or proceed in, or wait on, the A3 lay-by;
- (b) to enter or proceed in the slip road; or
- (c) to enter the side road from the slip road or to enter the slip road from the side road.

4. The provisions of article 3 above shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to -

- (a) a vehicle being used in connection with the said works;
- (b) a vehicle being used for police, ambulance, fire and rescue authority or traffic officer purposes;
- (c) anything done at the direction of, or with the permission of, a constable or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (d) any vehicle being used for winter maintenance purposes.
