**The A12 Trunk Road (Junction 26 Eight Ash Green Interchange,
Colchester, Essex) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of
Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - *20th August 2012*

Coming into force - - *27th August 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A12 Trunk Road (“the A12”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on some of those connecting roads in the County of Essex should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a) hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the A12 Trunk Road (Junction 26 Eight Ash Green Interchange, Colchester, Essex) Slip Roads (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 27th August 2012.

2. Subject as mentioned in article 3 of this Order no person shall, during a period of 10 hours starting at 20.00 hours on Tuesday 28th August 2012, or on any subsequent day until nearby local authority works have been completed, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the A12 northbound and southbound exit and entry slip roads at the A1124 Eight Ash Green Interchange, Colchester (Junction 26).

3. The provisions of article 2 of this Order shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall, from time to time, be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to a vehicle being used in connection with the works, or for police, fire and rescue authority or ambulance purposes or proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable.
