ROAD TRAFFIC

**The A590 Trunk Road (Barr End, Greenodd)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - - *24th January 2012*

Coming into force - - - - - *26th January 2012*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A590 Trunk Road, is satisfied that traffic on that road in District of South Lakeland in the County of Cumbria should be prohibited because of the likelihood of danger to the public:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (a), hereby makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A590 Trunk Road (Barr End, Greenodd) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th January 2012.

2. In this Order;

“the trunk road” means the A590 Trunk Road;

“the period of prohibition” means a period starting at 0001 hours on Friday 27 January 2012 and ending at 0001 hours on Monday 30 July 2012, or for such further period not exceeding 18 months ending when the said likelihood of danger to the public has passed;

“the layby to be closed” means the layby adjacent to the eastbound carriageway of the trunk road situated 135 metres east of the kerbed central reserve nosing at the western end of the dual carriageway;

“layby” means an area of carriageway, intended for the waiting of vehicles, bounded partly by a road marking on the outer edge of that carriageway complying with diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002 (b).

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4 of this Order, during the period of prohibition, no person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to enter or proceed in the layby to be closed.

4. The provisions of article 3 of this Order shall apply only at such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle being used for emergency purposes by the police, fire and rescue or ambulance services, vehicles being used in connection with the works, or by traffic officers, or to any vehicle proceeding at the direction, or with the permission, of a constable, or a traffic officer in uniform.
