**The M1 Motorway (Junctions 20 to 19, Leicestershire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 29th October 2012

Coming into force - - 5th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”) and connecting roads, is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway and on four of those connecting roads in the County of Leicestershire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 20 to 19, Leicestershire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 5th November 2012.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the southbound carriageway of the M1 from its junction with the exit slip road at Junction 20 to its junction with the link road leading from the southbound carriageway of the M6 at Junction 19;

“a slip road” means the slip road leading –

- i) to the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 20;
- ii) from the southbound carriageway of the M1 to the depot at Misterton;
- iii) to the southbound carriageway of the M1 from the depot at Misterton; and
- iv) from the southbound carriageway of the M1 at Junction 19;

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1.

“the works period”

means the period starting at 20.00 hours on Saturday 10th November 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the motorway or a slip road.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle –

- (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable, or traffic officer in uniform; or
- (iii) being used in connection with the said works or by a traffic officer in uniform.
