ROAD TRAFFIC

The A5 Trunk Road (South East of Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012

Made - - - - 19th November 2012

Coming into force - -26th November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road ("the A5"), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road south east of Atherstone in the County of Warwickshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by sections 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as The A5 Trunk Road (South East of Atherstone, Warwickshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 26th November 2012.

2. In this Order -

"the central reservation" means that part of the trunk road which separates its

carriageways for the safety and guidance of vehicular

traffic using that road;

"the works period" means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 3rd

December 2012 and ending when the said works have

been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

- **3.** Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed through the gap in the central reservation of the A5 situated opposite its junction with the A444 Atherstone Road.
- **4**. Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the A444 Atherstone Road at its junction with the A5.

5. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall apply only during such times and to such extent a shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
6. The provisions of articles 3 and 4 shall not apply to any vehicle -
(i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes,
(ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
(iii) being used in connection with the said works.
