**The A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge to Chellaston,
Staffordshire and Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic
in Laybys) Order 2012**

Made - - - - 16th November 2012

Coming into force - - 23rd November 2012

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A50 Trunk Road (“the A50”), is satisfied that traffic on lengths of that road, between Blythe Bridge and Chellaston in the counties of Staffordshire and Derbyshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A50 Trunk Road (Blythe Bridge to Chellaston, Staffordshire and Derbyshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic in Laybys) Order 2012 and shall come into force on 23rd November 2012.

2. In this Order –

“layby” means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

“the works period” means the period starting at 05.00 hours on Friday 30th November 2012 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in articles 4 and 5, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in any layby situated on the westbound or eastbound carriageway of the A50 between its roundabout junction with the A521 at Blythe Bridge and its roundabout junction with the A514 at Chellaston.
4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs.
5. The provisions of article 3 shall not apply to any vehicle -
 - (i) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
 - (ii) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable; or
 - (iii) being used for or in connection with the said works.
