**PREVENTION AND

**The Terrorism Act 2000 (Proscribed
Organisations) (Amendment) Order 2013**

Approved by both Houses of Parliament

Made - - - - 11th July 2013

Coming into force - - 12th July 2013

The Secretary of State makes the following Order in exercise of the power conferred by section 3(3) (a) of the Terrorism Act 2000⁽¹⁾.

The Secretary of State believes that the organisations to be added to Schedule 2 to that Act by article 2 of this Order are concerned in terrorism.

In accordance with section 123(4)(a) of that Act, a draft of this Order was laid before Parliament and approved by a resolution of each House of Parliament.

Citation and commencement

1. This Order may be cited as the Terrorism Act 2000 (Proscribed Organisations) (Amendment) Order 2013 and comes into force on the day after the day on which it is made.

Proscribed organisations

2. In Schedule 2 to the Terrorism Act 2000 (proscribed organisations)⁽²⁾, after the entry for Ansarul Muslimina Fi Biladis Sudan (Vanguard for the protection of Muslims in Black Africa) (Ansaru) insert the following entries—

“Jama’atu Ahli Sunna Lidda Awati Wal Jihad (Boko Haram)
Minbar Ansar Deen (Ansar Al Sharia UK)”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Order)

Part 2 of the Terrorism Act 2000 makes provision about proscribed organisations (including setting out offences in relation to such organisations in sections 11 to 13). An organisation is proscribed if it is listed in Schedule 2 to that Act or, in most cases, if it operates under the same name as an organisation so listed (section 3(1)).

Article 2 of this Order adds “Jama’atu Ahli Sunna Lidda Awati Wal Jihad (Boko Haram)” and “Minbar Ansar Deen (Ansar Al Sharia UK)” to the list in that Schedule.

An impact assessment has not been produced for this instrument as no impact on the private or voluntary sectors is foreseen.
