**The M1 Motorway (Junctions 16 to 17, Northamptonshire)
(Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013**

Made - - - - 2nd September 2013

Coming into force - - 9th September 2013

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the M1 Motorway (“the M1”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that motorway near Long Buckby in the County of Northamptonshire should be restricted because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order: -

1. This Order may be cited as the M1 Motorway (Junctions 16 to 17, Northamptonshire) (Temporary Restriction of Traffic) Order 2013 and shall come into force on 9th September 2013.

2. In this Order:

“the motorway” means the northbound carriageway of the M1 from the overbridge near Greenhill Farm, southwest of Long Buckby, to a point 1400 metres northwest of that overbridge;

“the works period” means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Monday 16th September 2013 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 4, no person shall, during the works period, drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on the motorway.

4. The provisions of article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs, and shall not apply to any vehicle –

(a) being used for police, fire brigade, ambulance or special forces purposes; or

(a) 1984 c.27; a new section 14 was substituted by the Road Traffic (Temporary Restrictions) Act 1991 (c.26), section 1(1) and Schedule 1

(b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable.
