**The A5 Trunk Road (Felton Butler - Churncote, Shropshire)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014**

Made - - - - *23rd December 2014*
Coming into force - - *30th December 2014*

WHEREAS the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A5 Trunk Road (“the A5”), is satisfied that traffic on a length of that road, between Felton Butler and Churncote in the County of Shropshire, should be prohibited because works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14 (1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), hereby makes the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the A5 Trunk Road (Felton Butler - Churncote, Shropshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 and shall come into force on Tuesday 30th December 2014.

2. In this Order –

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| “Felton Butler Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A5 and the unnamed roads leading to Felton Butler and Nesscliffe; |
| “Churncote Roundabout” | means the circulatory carriageway of the roundabout junction of the A5 and the A458 at Churncote; |
| “the trunk road” | means the northbound and southbound carriageways of the A5 between Felton Butler Roundabout and Churncote Roundabout; |
| “layby” | means an area of carriageway intended for the waiting of vehicles and bounded partly by a road marking of the type shown in diagram 1010 in Schedule 6 to the Traffic Signs Regulations 2002(b) and partly by the outer edge of that carriageway on the same side of the road as that on which the marking is placed; and in this definition “carriageway” means any way (other than a |

cycle track) comprised in a length of the trunk road over which the public have a right of way for the passage of vehicles and which has a suitable surface for the exercise of that right;

"the works period"

means the period starting at 20:00 hours on Tuesday 6th January 2015 and ending when the said works have been completed;

and a reference to an article followed by a number is a reference to the article in this Order which bears that number.

3. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed on the trunk road.

4. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or proceed in the laybys situated adjacent to the southbound carriageway of the A5—

- a) 120 metres southeast of Felton Butler Roundabout; and
- b) 185 metres northwest of Churncote Roundabout.

5. Subject as mentioned in article 6, no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to enter or leave the trunk road at its junction with any side road.

6. The provisions of articles 3, 4 and 5 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs and shall not apply to any vehicle -

- a) being used for police, fire brigade or ambulance purposes;
- b) proceeding at the direction of, or with the permission of, a police constable;
- c) being used in connection with the said works; or
- d) proceeding to or from premises which are accessible from, and only from, the trunk road.
