**The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford)  
Regulations 2015**

*Made* - - - - - *29th January 2015*

*Coming into force* - - - - - *23rd May 2015*

The Secretary of State has decided that it is necessary in the public interest to restrict flying in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire by reason of the holding of flying displays that are scheduled to take place on 23rd and 24th May, 11th and 12th July and 19th and 20th September 2015.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 161 of the Air Navigation Order 2009<sup>(a)</sup>.

**Citation and commencement**

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Duxford) Regulations 2015 and come into force on 23rd May 2015.

**Interpretation**

2. In regulation 3(1) all times referred to are Co-ordinated Universal Time<sup>(b)</sup>.

**Restricted airspace**

3.—(1) Subject to paragraph (2), between 1230 hours and 1700 hours on each of the following days—

- (a) 23rd and 24th May 2015,
- (b) 11th and 12th July 2015, and
- (c) 19th and 20th September 2015,

no aircraft is to fly below 4,500 feet above mean sea level within the area bounded by a circle having a radius of 2.2 nautical miles whose centre is at 520539N 0000753E.

(2) Paragraph (1) does not apply to any aircraft flying with the permission of the flying display director at Duxford Aerodrome.

(b) In these Regulations Co-ordinated Universal Time (UTC) is one hour behind British Summer Time (BST).

### **EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*(This note is not part of the Regulations)*

These Regulations impose restrictions on flying in airspace in the vicinity of Duxford, Cambridgeshire, during flying displays that are scheduled to be held there on 23-24 May, 11-12 July and 19-20 September 2015.

These events will be open to the general public, and a large number of aircraft will be involved in high-energy manoeuvres during the air shows. The Civil Aviation Authority considers that flying should be restricted in the vicinity of Duxford aerodrome for reasons of public safety and this has been agreed with the Department for Transport.

The times mentioned in regulation 3(1) are Universal Co-ordinated Time (UTC), which for the purpose of these Regulations is one hour behind British Summer Time.

Full details of the Statutory Instrument will be promulgated by Aeronautical Information Circular and NOTAM.
