ROAD TRAFFIC

The A1 Trunk Road (Derwentaugh to Eighton Lodge) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 Amendment Order 2015

Made - - - - 22nd January 2015

Coming into force - - 30th January 2015

WHEREAS, the Secretary of State for Transport, being the traffic authority for the A1 Trunk Road, and connecting roads, in the County of Tyne and Wear, is satisfied that traffic on that trunk road, and some of those connecting roads should be restricted and prohibited because carriageway widening and construction works are proposed to be executed thereon:

NOW, THEREFORE, the Secretary of State, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 14(1)(a) and 15(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984(a), makes the following Order:

1. This Order may be cited as the A1 Trunk Road (Derwentaugh to Eighton Lodge) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014 Amendment Order 2015 and shall come into force on 30th January 2015.
2. In article 3 of the A1 Trunk Road (Derwentaugh to Eighton Lodge) (Temporary Restriction and Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2014(b), is amended by inclusion of a 30 miles per hour speed restriction as follows:

Subject as mentioned in articles 5 and 10 no person shall, during the works period, cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour or 30 miles per hour in the first length of carriageway, the second length of carriageway or the first slip road.
