The Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations 2022

Made - - - - *9th August 2022*

Coming into force - - *10th August 2022*

The Secretary of State has previously decided that it is in the public interest to restrict flying by reason of the intended holding of flying displays by a jet formation display team and now wishes to amend the details for the flying displays which are due to be held in the vicinity of Eastbourne.

The Secretary of State makes the following Regulations in exercise of the powers conferred by article 239 of the Air Navigation Order 2016(a).

Citation and commencement

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) (Amendment) Regulations 2022 and they come into force on 10th August 2022.

Amendment of the Regulations

2. In the Schedule to the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) Regulations 2022(b) for “Eastbourne 504539N 0003714E 5,500 feet 18, 19, 20 and 21 August 2022” substitute “Eastbourne 504539N 0001714E 5,500 feet 18, 19, 20 and 21 August 2022”.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

(This note is not part of the Regulations)

These Regulations amend the Air Navigation (Restriction of Flying) (Jet Formation Display Teams) (No. 2) Regulations 2022 (S.I. 2022/658) by amending the coordinates for the displays which are intended to be held in the vicinity of Eastbourne.

(a) S.I. 2016/765, to which there are amendments not relevant to these Regulations.
(b) S.I. 2022/658.
