Your Excellency,

1 December, 1972

I have the honour to refer to the Agreement between the Government of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Northern Ireland and the Government of Sierra Leone for Air Services between and beyond their respective territories signed at Freetown on 5 April 1962.⁽¹⁾

I now have the honour to propose that the Schedule annexed to the Agreement be amended in the section headed "Routes to be Operated by the Designated Airline or Airlines of the United Kingdom" as follows:

In column 2, Intermediate Points, delete "Barcelona" and insert "Casablanca"; in column 4, Points Beyond, delete "Takoradi" and insert "Abidjan".

If the above proposals are acceptable to the Government of the Republic of Sierra Leone I have the honour to propose that this Note and your reply to that effect should be regarded as constituting an Agreement between our two Governments in this matter which shall enter into force on today's date.
