**ROAD TRAFFIC, WALES**

**The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 36A  
Broughton, Flintshire) (Temporary  
Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2017**

*Made* 11 September 2017

*Coming into force* 17 September 2017

The Welsh Ministers, being the traffic authority for the A55 Chester to Bangor Trunk Road, are satisfied that traffic on specified lengths of the trunk road should be prohibited because of works proposed on or near the road.

The Welsh Ministers, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred upon them by section 14(1) and (4) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984<sup>(1)</sup>, make this Order.

**Title, Interpretation and Commencement**

**1.** This Order comes into force on 17 September 2017 and its title is The A55 Trunk Road (Junction 36A Broughton, Flintshire) (Temporary Prohibition of Vehicles) Order 2017.

**2.** In this Order:

“exempted vehicle” (“*cerbyd esempt*”) means any vehicle being used by the emergency services and in connection with the works giving rise to this Order;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 Chester to Bangor link road from its junction with the A5104 Broughton Roundabout to, and including the Junction 36A Broughton Roundabout, and the Spur road from the Junction 36A Roundabout to the Broughton Retail Park, Broughton in the County of Flintshire;

“the trunk road” (“*y gefnffordd*”) means the A55 Chester to Bangor link road from its junction with the A5104 Broughton Roundabout to, and including the Junction 36A Broughton Roundabout, and the Spur road from the Junction 36A Roundabout to the Broughton Retail Park, Broughton in the County of Flintshire;

“works period” (“*cyfnod y gwaith*”) means the period commencing at 19:30 on the 17 September 2017 and ending when the temporary traffic signs are permanently removed.

### **Prohibition**

3. No person shall, during the works period, drive or cause or permit any vehicle, other than an exempted vehicle, to proceed in the lengths of the trunk road.

### **Application**

4. The prohibition in article 3 shall apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs.

### **Duration of this Order**

5. The maximum duration for this Order shall be 12 months.
